You will have a title for your piece, and also the title of the movie, and a short explanation of your artwork to describe what you are trying to convey to the viewers. You will be judged as always, on the merit of the art, not on your statement.

DID YOU KNOW

Continuing our walk through the Joslyn Sculpture Garden we come across a bench titled Bronze Bench #5.

The artist is Betty Woodman born 1930. She is internationally recognized as one of the most important sculptors working in clay today. While her primary medium is clay, Betty also works in bronze, glass and is a printmaker. One of her most significant innovoations is merging painting and ceramics, using glazes and paint to coat her pieces and drawing on the low-fire, colorful folk traditions of Mediterranean ceramics, mainly Italian.

Woodman has travelled quite a bit and finds her inspiration in cultures throughout the world.

Drawing no boundries between traditional fine art and craft, Betty Woodman takes elements from each and makes them her own. She uses the motif of the vase and the vessel over and over. "The centrality of the vase in my work is certainly a reference to a global perspective on art history and production. The container is a universal symbol – it holds and pours all fluids, stores foods and holds everything from flowers to our final remains".

Betty lived and worked in Colorado for part of every year from 1956 until she retired from the University of Colorado Art Department in 1998. She and her husband, George, a prominent painter and photographer now live and work in New York City and Antella, Italy.


