Sara Wamsat will be teaching 3D mixed media class “Make Your Muse”. Large or Small – Human or Animal-A Face or a Symbol Represent yourself or an unknown Spirit Character

What to Bring: A small mask or doll face/head (fuzzy, naked, hairy); scrap fabric, yarns, papers, tinfoil, junk drawer miscellaneous goodies that represent You!! (Old brushes, keys, broken jewelry, etc

I will have side cutters/pliers, newspaper, hammer, metal punches for you to use and faces & bead will be available to purchase. Your “Muse” will be whatever size your “Head” or “Face” begins as...To scale>>>the smaller the less you have to bring. The Larger.. the more ”stuff” you’ll need to make the rest of the body>>>it’s up to you. The more detail, the more you may need you have everything on hand>>Use your imagination>>assemble one or make a tribe. Start compiling your supplies. **Use YOUR imagination>>**

Retired from teaching for 35 years in Westside Community Schools, Heimbuch experiments with transparent glazes and surface textures. "While I am painting, I might start thinking about how the composition is starting to show a feeling like snow falling, bugs swarming around a light bulb, water rushing down a sink drain, or frost on a kitchen window," Heimbuch said. "When this happens, I follow that inspiration in finishing the painting."
