Mixed Media with Lisa Lathrop. Lisa was the winner of the Opal Parmeter award in 2013. She took that opportunity to delve into Mixed Media by one-on-one instruction from two Mixed Media artists in the Omaha area. With this instruction she has learned papermaking, unique ways to use acrylic paints, and incorporates found objects in her work. Lisa will be leading us in the techniques she learned in the workshops she attended.

Lisa will have hand-made paper and sun-printed fabrics available (\$1.50 each). The list of materials includes required items (denoted by *) and suggestions ~ feel free to bring additional materials to create a piece of artwork based on one of the four seasons.

1. 8x8 canvas, canvas board, or mat Board*
2. Gel medium, gloss or matte*
3. Acrylic paints and Brushes*
4. Palette*
5. Craft glue (such as Alene's)
6. Scissors / exacto knife*
7. Clear acetate or clear page protectors (for image transfers).
8. Misc items to include is based on the seasonal theme: wire, ribbon, bells, gems, beads, recycled greeting cards, calendars, poems, inspirational quotes, newspaper, wrapping paper, old broke jewelry, tissue or crepe paper, plastic or fabric flowers, feathers, or other found objects.

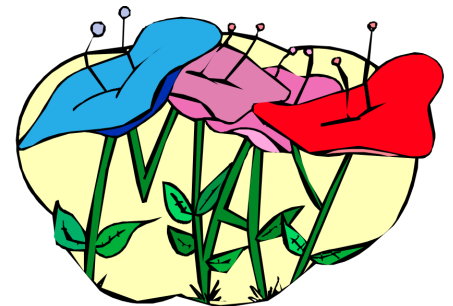

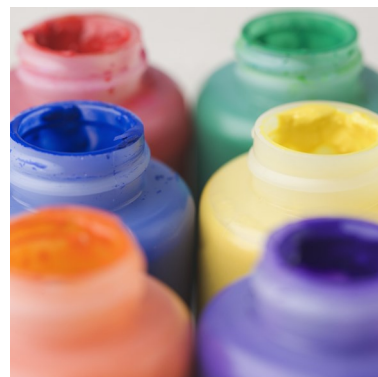
