Unscented Hair Spray or Workable Fixative

Mask (if you feel you need)

Non-latex type gloves

Q-Tips, Cotton Balls

September 13—October 30, 2016 No Theme Cost: \$15 for up to 3 pieces

No artwork may be entered that is more than 2 years old. No Commission Charge.

Size restrictions for this show:

- 3 pieces 11 x 14 or smaller (area of 154 square inches or smaller)
- 2 pieces when no larger than 24 x 30 (area of 720 square inches or smaller)
- 1 piece larger than 24 x 30, maximum size 40 x 40 (1600 square inches)

Sizes may also be figured by adding two adjacent sides, so smallest no bigger than 25 (11 + 14), middle size 54, (24 + 30), and largest when two sides added together are greater than 54 but no larger than 80.
