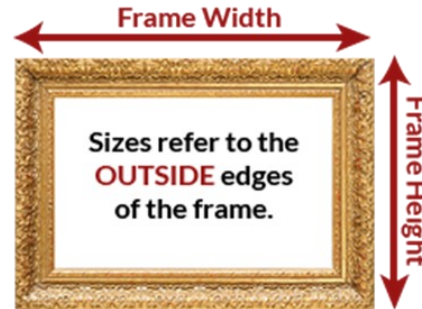
This theme is very general, so you can interpret it in any way you like.
