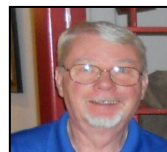

The **OAI Fall Art Show** will be at La Casa restaurant on 4432 Leavenworth St. Registration will be on Monday, September 18 from 11-1. The reception will be held the following Monday September 25th, 5 - 7 pm. Take down on Monday, Nov. 6 from 11-1 pm. There is no theme. Size restrictions apply.

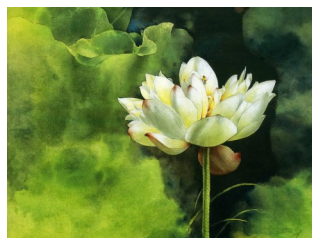


The **Winter Show** will be held at the Jewish Community Center - with registration on January 2, 2018. We will remind you with an email for the show since the newsletter will not be out before. There is no theme. Size restrictions apply. The reception will be on Sunday, Jan. 7 from 2-4. Take down is Wednesday, January 24 from 11 - 1.



The **Spring Show** will be early this year at the Hot Shops - with registration on Tuesday, February 27, 2018 from 11-1. Reception Sunday, March 4 from 2 - 4. Take down on Sunday, April 1. The **THEME FOR THIS SHOW** will be "**The Artful Letter**" - Through art, show how the written word inspires. (Example - positive, negative, poetry, a word, a thought or a phrase) You will want to include with your entry a short written statement about the word or words that inspired you, to put alongside your artwork. Size restrictions apply.

Exciting news— We have a **4TH ART SHOW IN 2018** at **Lauritzen Gardens!!!** - it will run from June 6 through July 24! Of course your art piece must be in some way related to plants - whether it be a landscape or a figure in a garden or a portrait of a woman with flowers in her hat, etc. I know we will have some creative uses of the botanical theme. There will be a 25% commission fee for Lauritzen if a piece sells, so price accordingly.



Size restrictions are the usual - 3 pieces allowed if 11x 14 or smaller, 2 pieces if 30x30, (and to clarify this rule - if one piece is 30x30, then you can only enter 2 pieces), and one piece if it is larger than 30x30. Sculptures are not restricted to any size limit, but each artist can enter a maximum of 3 pieces of art for the **\$15 entry fee**.

Please Note that you may not renew your membership or join Omaha Artists during registration of an art show. Dues and membership forms must be submitted at least one week prior to an art show in order to be a member in good standing to participate in an art show. The art show committee is not equipped to take people's dues or handle membership. Thank you for your understanding.
